

How do I register my child?

Registration is done through our website. You will find the registration tab in the upper right-hand corner.

When does Registration open and close?

Registration opens in November and closes mid-January.

How long is the softball season?

Practices begin in February with games starting in March and running through the middle of May

When and where are practices?

Practices are held at the Blue Park Fields, Jade St Park and a few neighboring schools (i.e. Shoreline) Teams practice twice a week up until games begin. Our 6U division will practice/play twice a week through the season and older divisions will practice/play three times a week. The coaching staff makes final decisions on practices once games start and they pick time of practice based on what is best for them.

When will I be notified of what team my child is on?

Teams will be formed in early February and all notifications will be sent through our website.

Can I choose which team my daughter plays on?

6U and 8U divisions may request but there is no guarantee. We do our best but also need to make sure players are divided equally between teams. There are no requests allowed for 10U and older division as these are drafted divisions.

What days and times are games played?

Game days are Tuesday through Thursday and on Saturdays. Weekday games are either at 4:30 or 6pm and Saturday games run from 9am to 4pm. The 6U division only plays games on Saturdays and all other divisions will play one weekday game and one Saturday game.

How long are games?

Each division has different time limits. 6U games are 1 hour long and the other divisions vary between 75 minutes to 90 minutes long.

What equipment is supplied by the league?

The league provides jerseys and will have spare bats, balls, batting helmets and catchers gear.

What equipment do I need to get for my child?

Black pants for games, socks *usually a team theme, glove, softball cleats. We do recommend each player having their own batting helmet (must have face guard attached) but this is not required.

Is there a competitive feeder softball program?

Yes, Crushers. You can find information about Crushers on our website. Tryouts for this program are usually towards the end of rec season.
